### World Autism Awareness Day-April 2nd


Because Autism is a complex spectrum of disorders, raising awareness is critical. On December 18, 2007, the United Nations General Assembly adopted resolution 62/139,

tabled by the State of Qatar, which declares April 2 as World Autism Awareness Day (WAAD) in perpetuity. The State of Qatar, supported the campaign for a World Autism Awareness Day through the current 62nd UN General Assembly Session, garnering consensus support from all United Nations Member States. This UN resolution is one of only three official disease-specific United Nations Days and will bring the world's attention to autism, a pervasive disorder that affects tens of millions. The World Autism Awareness Day resolution encourages all Member States to take measures to raise awareness about autism throughout society and to encourage early diagnosis and early intervention. It further expresses deep concern at the prevalence and high rate of autism in children in all regions of the world and the consequent developmental challenges. It was first observed in 2008.



### World Health Day-April 7th

Every year, World Health Day is celebrated on 7 April to mark the anniversary of the founding of WHO in 1948. Each year a theme is selected for World Health Day that highlights a priority area of concern for WHO. World Health Day is a global campaign, inviting everyone – from global leaders to the public in all countries – to focus on a single health challenge with global impact. Focusing on new and emerging health issues, World Health Day provides an opportunity to start collective action to protect people's health and well-being.



### World Haemophilia Day-April 17th

World Hemophilia Day is celebrated on 17 April. This day is celebrated by haemophilia organisations around the world, and gives them an opportunity to increase awareness of haemophilia. World Haemophilia Day was started in 1989. The World Federation of Haemophilia (WHF) chose 17 April in honour of WFH founder Frank Schnabel, who was born on that day. This day many inspire others with their story of living with or treating this bleeding disorder and show their commitment to achieving treatment for all.



### World Earth Day-April 22nd

The first Earth Day on April 22, 1970, activated 20 million Americans from all walks of life and is widely credited with launching the modern environmental movement. The passage of the landmark Clean Air Act, Clean Water Act, Endangered Species Act and many other groundbreaking environmental laws soon followed. Growing out of the first Earth Day, Earth Day Network (EDN) works with over 22,000 partners in 192 countries to broaden, diversify and mobilize the environmental movement. More than 1 billion people now participate in Earth Day activities each year, making it the largest civic observance in the world.
