
X CONVOCATION - 2016

The Business School reopens on 4th July

The Auroras Business School reopened on 4th July, 2016. after smmer vacation. The \$th Trimester classes commenced immediately.

PGDM First year Students go on Smmer Internship Work

Students of 1st Year PGDM, who finished their first three Trimesters successfully went on summer internship projects and made their field studies.

Entrepreneurship Educator Program

An intensive Three-day Enterpreneurshipf Education Program for faculty who are keen to become entrepreneurship educators was organized from 14th to 16th July 2016. Participants of this program went through facilitated sessions on Entrepreneurship Concepts, Entrepreneurship Pedagogy, and Entrepreneur Development. Participants were enabled to appreciate the need to facilitate entrepreneurship programs on campus to develop an understanding of entrepreneurship idea generation, opportunity evaluation, developing business models, and business plans. They were familiarized with the global best practices in entrepreneurship education. The program was laced with a number exercises, activities and simulations. Seventy five participants from fifty different educational institutions (post graduation and graduation) attended this programme. Dr V Sree Jyothi and Prof.C Kameswari coordinated this program under the guidance of Dr. Raghu N Prabhakar, Incharge Director of Aurora's Business School.

Telangana Ku Haritha Haram Program

Telangana Haritha Haaram, a flagship programme of the Telangana Government, envisages increasing the present 24% tree cover in the State to 33% of the total geographical area of the State. In this context, Aurora's Business School organised a Haritha Haram program on its campus on 18th July, 2016. The program was marked with tree plantationand lectures on environmental sanity. Business School students took the initiative in collecting saplings from GHMC nursery at Erragadda and planting them in the School surroundings. Speakers highlighted the Imbalances in ecology and the consequent need for afforestation, water conservation, and protection of environment. Prof. Venugopal and Prof Sunil, faculty of the School speaking on the occasion said that a day might come when water would have to be bought for taking a bath. If plants were raised all around, they would give fresh air and make the surroundings healthy. If trees were felled, mankind would not have a future.

Govenor Advises Microfinance Institutions Ethically
